To whom it may concern:

This letter confirms that all MCCA presidents/chancellors have agreed that students from any of the member community colleges qualify for an in-district tuition rate when they participate in a study abroad program or take a foreign language course offered by another member college.

The goal of the agreement is to promote international education through study abroad programs and foreign language courses.

This practice was initially and officially approved by MCCA in 2011 on the request of the Missouri Consortium for Global Education (MCGE). Since then the policy has been ratified by the MCCA presidents/chancellors on two separate occasions in 2017 and 2018.
